Supplemental Support Under the American Rescue Plan

The Supplemental Support Under the American Rescue Plan (SSARP) is governed by section 2003 of the ARP and section 314 of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) (Pub. L. 116-260) for institutions serving a high percentage of low- income students and experiencing enrollment declines.

Students must meet the following eligibility requirements:

• Students must be enrolled in Spring 2023 for a minimum of one (1) credit hour in a program that leads to a certificate, diploma, or degree.

Exclusions:

- Dual Enrolled
- Foreign Students
- Transient Students

Proposed Process for Awarding and Disbursing SAIHE Grant Funds to Students:

Based on the eligibility requirements above, SGTC initially identified 990 students for Spring Semester 2023 to receive SSARP Grant Funds. SGTC disbursed funds to students based on financial need (EFC) and enrollment status (part-time or full time). Funds were awarded by the Financial Aid Department and disbursed to student accounts. Each student account showed a credit balance. SSARP funds can be used to cover tuition and fees balances, if the student gives prior authorization. The Business Office disbursed any credit balance to BankMobile for release to the student.
